Simon Jacob, a journalist and book author who grew up in Augsburg, came to Germany in 1980. In his original homeland, South Anatolia, conflicts were the daily fare. His parents were looking for a new home. Jacob was two years old at the time. Decades later, as initiator of the peace project "Peacemaker", he made his way back to the Middle East - where war and suffering drive millions away.

Equipped with camera and notepad, he knew, as so many others who had arrived in Europe, that the solution for the Middle East could be found in Europe's responses to developments after the Second World War..

Europe is a peace project and more than just open borders, the Euro or the opportunity to work anywhere in a secure environment.

Europe is a vision of peaceful coexistence. Those who have experienced wars and who come to Europe in order to be able to participate in that peace are particularly aware of this.

In the documentation, not only actors from the Middle East and Europe get their chance to speak. The narrative strands are vividly documented from two different perspectives, which in the end are interwoven into a vision. Namely, that lasting peace is possible - built on the ruins of a Europe after devastating wars.
